Control (Excerpt)

ROCKY: A teenage girl RAINE : A teenage girl

ASHLEY: A girl in her twenties

BEN: An old man

[The stage is comprised of elements and pieces, which each belong to a different location. The set pieces should not be dividing the stage or stopping the actors from using the full space, but rather create a core for the location which they represent, from which the action can spawn from. Lights should not go down between scenes. Instead, the actor who is lingering into the next scene can stay in the moment, before being broken out of it by the arrival or by the voice of another character.]

Scene 1

[From outside the door we hear voices and laughter. ROCKY and RAINE enter.]

RAINE: Oh look at that!

ROCKY: Hey!

It works this time!

RAINE: [Exiting into the other room] My handy craft is flawless my friend

ROCKY: Oh really?

What was it A WR5?

RAINE: [Off] It's a Y1

ROCKY: A Y1?

[*After a moment*]

RAINE: [Entering with a bottle of vodka] Yes

ROCKY: You didn't happen to find anything to mix that with?

RAINE: Well

No

I did not want to check

ROCKY: Okay

Well

RAINE: BECAUSE

Wait BECAUSE

One would remember how much juice they had

But they aren't going to remember how much vodka they had

I mean

By the time they put away the bottle You see

ROCKY: You trying to get me drunk?

RAINE: No!

I'm trying to get us drunk!

So raise your glass

And I know that you don't have a glass

But you can raise it

To

Hang on

[Pops outside and reads a piece of mail]

Mr. Tony Findley

ROCKY: Ahh delicious

RAINE: You can do it for real now

[Passes her the bottle]

ROCKY: Not so delicious

RAINE: You jealous I got his phone number?

ROCKY: What do you mean am I jealous?

RAINE: That I got it and you didn't have the guts?

ROCKY: No

I'm very impressed with you

RAINE: Thank you m'lady Anything cool around?

ROCKY: What?

His stuff?

Yeah there's cool stuff

RAINE: Woah! This is dope!

ROCKY: You can't take it

RAINE: Why?

ROCKY: Those are the rules

RAINE: Well when it's your key it's your rules

And it's my key So stinkers lady

It's mine

ROCKY: Oh

You're a key cutter and you're a big shot

RAINE: Take a swig

ROCKY: I'm going to get some pop or something

RAINE: Fuck off Take your swig

ROCKY: No!

I don't want my fucking swig

RAINE: You mad cause I took this fucking

Thing?

ROCKY: Yes

I am Raine

Because that's stupid

And that's how we'll get caught

And I don't want to do this with you if you're going to be a bitch about it

RAINE: Okay

Okay

I'm sorry

We'll make new rules

Okay?

Okay?

Man?

Rocky?

Man?

We'll compromise

ROCKY: What new rules?

RAINE: It's like the vodka

We won't take anything that they'll miss

Or remember

Okay?

Okay?

ROCKY: Give me my fucking swig

RAINE: We'll take something that's meaningful to the night

And the person

Without it being something they'll miss

I'll take this pencil

Okay?

And we'll both chew a mark on it

Okay?

ROCKY: Okay I like that

RAINE: Good

Scene 2

ASHLEY: So yeah, the blade's attached to the one end and the

This thing

Here

This just

Like

Piece of metal

Is on the other side

Yeah?

ROCKY: Yeah

Cool

ASHLEY: So the piece of metal feels the grooves and the blade cuts the blank key

So that Ideally

The blank key fits in the lock

Anyway

We'll come back to that

The main thing to get is the key blank

Alright?

ROCKY: Alright

ASHLEY: Cool

So

The main three types of house keys are WR5's

KW1's And Uh These SC1's

Look at the ridges

You see the difference?

ROCKY: Yeah

What are the names again?

ASHLEY: Uh

KW

Actually

You know what?

Fuck it

Don't worry about that right now

It's easy

I know it's overwhelming

But like

I've only been working here for like two months

So it doesn't really matter you know?

Scene 3

RAINE: How did you know she was on vacation?

ROCKY: She told me

RAINE: What?

ROCKY: She was a really bitchy customer

And she insisted that she needed them for a certain date

Cause she was going on vacation

RAINE: So you broke into her house?

Do you always break into houses of difficult customers?

ROCKY: No Alright

Here's what happened

I was working with this really dumb chick who sucks at cutting keys

RAINE: How long have you been working there?

ROCKY: Like

Fuck

Like three weeks

Anyway

RAINE: You've been working there for three weeks and you're breaking into houses?

What are you? A maniac?

Saying she's bad at cutting keys

How good can you be?

ROCKY: No wait

ľm **Iust**

Shut the fuck up okay?

RAINE: Okay

ROCKY: I was working with this lovely girl

But she was cutting keys for this bitchy woman who said she was going on vacation

Alright?

RAINE: Okay

ROCKY: But

The girl fucked up the keys

RAINE: Oh cause she sucks at cutting keys!

ROCKY: Exactly

So

The lady brings them back

I'm working

And the lady brings them back

And she's all pissed off cause they didn't work

And cause she's going on vacation in like

Two days Or whatever

So I re-cut them for her

And I'm the bomb at key cutting By the way

So they're awesome

Of course

But she still wants her money back

RAINE: Cause they probably didn't work

ROCKY: No Smart guy

I mean right after

Like right after I cut them

Like the second set

She didn't even try them yet

RAINE: Okay

Got it

ROCKY: So I said

Like

You know

You gotta choose

Like

The keys or the money

Like

I can't give you the keys

I can't give you free keys

Not like I'd want to give her free keys if she's being a bitch

But she's pissed off

And so she tells me to phone my general manager

Which I do

And the manager is just like

Why

Like

What are you talking about?

Like

Obviously we can't do it

Like I'm an idiot

So I'm like

Yeah okay

And I do this refund for this woman

And she keeps asking me

Right?

Like

So there's really no reimbursement for me coming all the way up here?

And like

I live on the other side of the city and I can't afford to come here twice in one week

Well

Boo hoo

Don't come across town to get your fucking keys cut then

And she's got \$400 sunglasses and a Gucci purse so

Yeah

So I do the refund

And she leaves

Keyless

And the keys are sitting on the counter

And I can't help but thinking

Like

Maybe this is just some scheme

Like some con that she does

All over town

To like

All the key stores

So she can get free keys

And

So

Like

I was curious

Right?

And I was still pissed about her being a bitch

So

I went to her house

And I was gonna

Like

I don't know

I just

I wanted to see if the keys worked

You know?

Cause I mean

I made them

So I tried them

And they worked

So I was like

Well

Let's get drunk in this bitch's house

Scene 4

ASHLEY: So if you like

Fuck up a key

Then just put it in this book

Alright?

ROCKY: Yeah

ASHLEY: There's like a spot where it says like

What key it is

And how you fucked it up

ROCKY: Is that cause

Like

So people aren't stealing keys?

ASHLEY: Well Yeah I guess

But I mean it's more just so they know how many keys they have

Right?

Like

Okay

We get boxes of keys

Like

Little boxes of keys

When we're out of a blank

Right?

And every time you sell a key we have one less key in the inventory

And every time you fuck one up As long as you put it in this book

It gets counted On the computer

ROCKY: So you guys keep track of all of the keys?

ASHLEY: No

Like

Okay

No one cares about if people steal keys

Like I dunno

I stole these

Like

I mean I'm not going to pay for my keys if I work at a key cutting place

But like I dunno

Especially if it's a WR5 or a KW1

ROCKY: Or an SC1?

ASHLEY: Right Good girl Like

We have tons of those So we get tons of boxes

People expect these to sell big

So we get tons of boxes of these all the time

ROCKY: How many do we sell?

ASHLEY: Keys?

Like Oh Well

I don't know about daily

But say we sold a hundred keys

Probably ninety of them are those main three

ROCKY: So nobody notices them?

ASHLEY: Well Fuck man

I don't want to be telling you to steal keys during your training

But yeah I mean

Nobody really cares Especially those ones

You know?

But

I dunno

Don't do it if the district manager is here

Scene 5

RAINE: So how did you find her house?

ROCKY: There's this little place

On the computer

When you do a refund

Where you ask for their name and their number

RAINE: So she put in her name and you looked it up in the phonebook?

ROCKY: No

The phonebook doesn't

Like

Who's listed in the phonebook now?

RAINE: What?

ROCKY: Nobody's listed in the phonebook

RAINE: Well how'd you find it then?

ROCKY: Well

Okay

Here's the fucking weird thing

Is

She said her name was

I was doing the name phone number thing and I asked like

Phone number

And she gives me her phone number

Like pretty straight up

But I can tell she's getting real annoyed

And so I was like

First name

And she says

Liberty

Which is

I dunno

But I'm really curious for the last name now

So I say last name

And she says Justice

Like

Liberty Justice

Like

Liberty Justice is her name

RAINE: What?

ROCKY: So it's obviously a fake name right?

RAINE: Well how did you find the house with a fake name?

How would that help you?

ROCKY: It doesn't

RAINE: What?

ROCKY: It Okay It doesn't

It's not about her name

Like

Okay

If you type a phone number into google it tells you where that person lives

Like ninety percent of the time

It doesn't have anything to do with the fake name

I just thought it was a good story

RAINE: Well how do you know she didn't give you a fake number?

ROCKY: When?

RAINE: Like how do you know it wasn't a fake number

And then you just like

Found a random house based on the number

And broke into a random house

And we're just sitting in this random person's house

ROCKY: Well because the key wouldn't work

Right?

RAINE: Oh yeah

ROCKY: Or

Yeah

I mean

That'd be really fucked up if it did

Scene 6

BEN: What are you doing?

RAINE: What do you mean?

I'm reading

BEN: My god

I thought it was quiet

RAINE: Fuck you

BEN: Don't say that shit in my house

[Sitting] Oh lord

Did I ever

I used to live with some Hari Krishna's At a retreat For awhile

RAINE: Yeah?

BEN: Real eastern devotees A long time ago I thought I was real into it because I'd read the Bhagavad Gita And a few other books Wasn't what I thought I suppose

RAINE: What happened?

BEN: Mmm?

RAINE: Why'd you stop living there?

BEN: Turns out they weren't any less judgmental than anyone else

And they didn't believe in evolution

You're sure quiet today

RAINE: I'm trying to read

BEN: Come here

RAINE: Why?

BEN: Just come here

Are you okay?

RAINE: How come every time I'm happy

Someone asks me if I'm alright?

Does that mean something's wrong with me?

BEN: Nothing's wrong with you

[Silence]

RAINE: Are you okay?

BEN: I'm great Thank you

Nobody's asked me that in a very long time

RAINE: I'm sorry

BEN: No I'm No

You're not

You get to a certain age and people You get to a certain age and you stop making friends You know?

RAINE: You're my friend [He smiles. Silence.]

BEN: You know how I said there are things behind your senses

RAINE: Yes

BEN: In front of your eyes

RAINE: Yeah

BEN: Are you hiding here?

RAINE: What?

[A very long moment of connection. BEN kisses RAINE on the forehead]

BEN: Go home

Scene 7

ASHLEY: So nothing went funky with the key cutting But just in case they don't work for whatever reason Hang on to your receipt Within thirty days you can re-cut them Or refund them Or whatever you need

BEN: Thank you very much

[BEN exits]

ASHLEY: So do you live pretty close to here?

ROCKY: Yeah I just moved

ASHLEY: From?

ROCKY: Airdrie

ASHLEY: Oh wow

You know lots of people up here then?

Down here? Where's Airdrie?

ROCKY: Yeah Down here

No

I don't have a lot of friends

I know like One girl Which is I mean

I thought it would be cool

But like Yeah I dunno

She moved here awhile ago

And has friends from school

So

I mean I dunno

I guess I don't really know her that well anymore

So yeah

Not many friends

I've just been chillin' by myself a lot

ASHLEY: Well I'm Ashley

And you know me

And we can hang out whenever you want

So hah That's two
